

## TEAS Pre-Admission Exam Practical Nursing Fall 2024 Program - Thomasville and Tifton Campuses Program Application Deadline: June 27, 2024

Once accepted to Southern Regional Technical College all PN applicants are required to take and attain the required score on the Pre-Admission Assessment (TEAS) exam, prior to being accepted into the Practical Nursing Program. The ATI TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) is a timed exam that includes questions in the following area: English, Math, Reading and Science.

The total TEAS score requirement for the PN program is 56%. Students are allowed two (2) attempts within a 12-month period to make the program required score. If a second attempt is needed you will be required to take all sections of the exam.

You may register for the TEAS exam by calling or stopping by any of the SRTC Student Affairs offices. *The TEAS exam fee of \$75 must be paid prior to the exam.*

However, applicants can reapply to the PN Program and take the PN Pre-Admission exam again after waiting <u>one</u> year. At such time, the applicant will be allowed two attempts to meet the qualifying PN Pre-Admission TEAS Assessment exam scores.
