STUDENT EMAIL

SRTC student email accounts are available for all students. Students are required to use this email account when communicating with instructors and classmates in your courses.

You can now access your e-mail account by going to the following address (please note this is NOT Google, your email has changed): <https://outlook.office.com>

Username: Your username is your entire e-mail address (first initial, last name, last four digits of your student ID number). Example: jdoe1122@stu.southernregional.edu

Password: Your password is now your first initial, last initial, _, your student ID number. So for John Doe (ID# 900001122) the password is JD_900001122. The initials are both capital letters. You will not be able to change your password upon logging in.

*If you do not have your student id number it can be found on your schedule or by logging into Bannerweb.

SRTCAlert SYSTEM

Contact information for all SRTC students is entered into the SRTCAlert System database at the beginning of each semester. This automated system will contact you via phone message, text message, and/or email in emergency and non-emergency situations, such as, inclement weather, school closings, or danger on campus. Please be sure that all of your contact information is current and accurate each semester by informing the Student Affairs office of any changes.

BANNERWEB

To view your schedule, financial aid, and other important student information, login to BANNERWEB. Click on the link located at the top right of the SRTC website home page.

- Your user ID will be your nine-digit student ID number
- Your password will be your six-digit birthdate: mmddyy
