** Prerequisites to Program Admission.

*** A Criminal Background Check is required at the student's expense prior to the start of clinicals to allow for accurate career advisement on clinical placement eligibility, eligibility for certifying boards, and employment opportunities upon graduation.

**** A physical is required at the student's expense prior to the start of clinicals. Must have physical immunizations (esp. Measles & Tetanus), blood work (RPR) and TB skin test or chest x-ray. If TB skin test is positive or previous TB skin test was positive, must follow-up with a chest x-ray. The physical must contain current information within the last one year.

***** Uniform expense includes: watch with a second hand, Stethoscope, and lab coat with school patch on left sleeve, and ID Tag
