The National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Sciences Review Committee recommended to the Review Board that your institution's medical laboratory technician - associate degree program be awarded initial accreditation for four (4) years.

To support the operation of NAACLS, it is necessary to assess an annual accreditation fee of \$600.00 for each accredited program and \$25.00 for each recognized clinical affiliate. The income from the fees is used to cover the operating cost of conducting the accreditation services for which NAACLS is responsible. NAACLS continues to monitor all expenses carefully and makes every effort to operate within its budget.

The accreditation fee is assessed July 1st, the beginning of NAACLS' fiscal year. Fees for programs awarded accreditation after the beginning of the fiscal year are prorated. Your program is being assessed a total of \$524.88 for fiscal year 1994-95, from October 1, 1994 to June 30, 1995 as indicated on the enclosed invoice #4101. Payment is due no later than December 1, 1994. If this date cannot be met, please advise NAACLS Accounting Department.
