Tuition and fees are paid at registration. Books are purchased the first day of each quarter. Tuition is based on full-time status. Out-of-state residents pay \$178 per credit hour in tuition, except Jefferson, Gadsden, Leon Counties, and all of Alabama.

** Prerequisites to Program Admission.

**** A physical is required at the student's expense prior to the start of clinicals. Must have physical immunizations (esp. Measles & Tetanus), blood work (RPR) and TB skin test or chest x-ray. If TB skin test is positive or previous TB skin test was positive, must follow-up with a chest x-ray. The physical must contain current information within the last one year. A dental exam is also required.

*** A Criminal Background Check is required at the student's expense prior to the start of clinicals to allow for accurate career advisement on clinical placement eligibility, eligibility for certifying boards, and employment opportunities upon graduation.
