Dear Students,

As part of the third wave of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF), the Department of Education has made funds available through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 to post-secondary institutions to distribute grants to students to ensure learning continues for students during the COVID-19 pandemic. Southern Regional Technical College has received these funds.

Students **do not need to apply** for this funding. This is not a loan, does not have to be paid back, and it does not cover balances already owed. SRTC has released these funds. Please know that not all students will be eligible for this aid. Aid is awarded based on the qualifications released by the act itself and is based on established need and credit hours enrolled at the beginning of the semester.

SRTC's Federal School Code is 005615. The upcoming 2022-2023 aid year is open to apply as well. This aid will begin in Fall 2022. If you are planning to attend, please go ahead and apply for aid.
