

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN ABRAHAM BALDWIN AGRICULTURAL
COLLEGE SCHOOL OF ARTS AND SCIENCES BACHELOR OF SCIENCE DEGREE
PROGRAMS AND SOUTHERN REGIONAL TECHNICAL COLLEGE INTERDISCIPLINARY
STUDIES (GENERAL EDUCATION) ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE DEGREE**

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Southern Regional Technical College (hereinafter "SRTC") has students who will graduate with an Interdisciplinary Studies (General Education Track) A.A.S. degree and who have intentions to continue their education at Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College (hereinafter "ABAC"); and

WHEREAS, both institutions are desirous of facilitating the smooth transition of SRTC Interdisciplinary Studies (General Education Track) A.A.S. degree students into appropriate B.S. degree program at ABAC; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to set forth their respective responsibilities and understandings in relation thereto;

AGREEMENT

NOW, therefore in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties, intending to be legally bound hereby, agree as follows:

1. Effective Date and Term of Agreement. February 25, 2025, shall be the effective date of this Agreement. The term of this Agreement shall be five (5) years from the effective date stated above. The Agreement may be renewed upon mutual signed written Agreement.
2. Acceptance of Students. SRTC students who wish to seek admission into any ABAC degree program must meet the standard admission requirements set forth by ABAC in accordance with applicable University System of Georgia policies.
3. Curriculum. Exhibit A contains the now current SRTC Interdisciplinary Studies (General Education Track) A.A.S. curriculum and the ABAC equivalents of those SRTC courses, where available. Exhibit B contains program-to-program transfer maps that plot which of the SRTC Interdisciplinary Studies (General Education Track) A.A.S. program courses transfer to satisfy specific requirements of appropriate ABAC School of Arts and Sciences B.S. degree programs, specifically, the Biology B.S., History & Government B.S., Rural Community Development B.S., and Writing & Communication B.S. It is acknowledged by this Agreement that ABAC, as the B.S. degree-granting institution, is ultimately responsible for the credits which make up their degrees. This Agreement does not limit the transfer of any appropriate SRTC course to ABAC nor does it limit the ability of Interdisciplinary Studies (General Education Track) A.A.S. degree students to apply to other ABAC programs. In all cases, to be eligible for a baccalaureate degree from ABAC, the student must complete a minimum of 30 semester hours toward the degree in residence at ABAC, including at least 21 semester hours of upper-division (3000 level or above) course work in the major field and at least 39 semester hours of upper division work overall. Resident credit is defined as credit earned at ABAC. Upper division is defined as 3000- and 4000-level courses.

4. Amendment of Requirements. During the term of this Agreement, SRTC may amend its curriculum or requirements for the Interdisciplinary Studies (General Education Track) A.A.S. degree and ABAC may amend its requirements for the School of Arts and Sciences Bachelor of Science degree programs. In the event significant amendments occur, the amending party shall notify the other of any substantial changes no later than April 1 of the year in which the changes are made, so that appropriate updates to this Agreement may be made in a timely fashion that optimally serves students.

5. Literature on the Agreement. The parties agree that both SRTC and ABAC may feature information about this Agreement in their respective catalogues, admissions activities, career counseling, and online and printed materials, provided that the literature or information describing the Agreement is approved in advance by both SRTC and ABAC.

6. Representatives. Each party shall designate a representative responsible for expediting and directing applications and admissions resulting from this Agreement.

7. Termination of Agreement. SRTC or ABAC may terminate this Agreement for any or no reason with ninety (90) days advanced written notice. Either party may terminate this Agreement in writing in the event of a substantial breach which remains uncured following thirty (30) days prior notice within notice of breach.

8. Interpretation of the Agreement. The laws of the State of Georgia shall govern this Agreement. This agreement is also subject to the policies of the University System of Georgia and the Technical College System of Georgia. If any provision of this Agreement shall be illegal, void or unenforceable, the remaining portion shall remain in full force and effect. In the event either party is unable to perform hereunder because of circumstances beyond its reasonable control, the obligation shall be suspended for the duration of the cause of the inability to perform.

9. Modification of Agreement. This Agreement shall only be modified in writing with the same formality as the original Agreement.


10. Relationship of Parties. The relationship between the parties of this Agreement to each other is that of independent contractors. The relationship of the parties to this contract to each other shall not be construed to constitute a partnership, joint venture or any other relationship, other than that of independent contractors.

11. Liability. Neither of the parties shall assume any liabilities to each other. As to liability to each other or death to persons, or damages to property, the parties do not waive any defense as a result of entering into this Agreement. There are no third-party beneficiaries of this Agreement. Under no circumstances shall either party be liable to the other for any indirect, incidental, special or consequential damages of any kind.

12. Entire Agreement. This Agreement represents the entire understanding between the parties. This Agreement supersedes any prior agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof. No other prior or contemporaneous oral or written understanding or promises exist in regards to this relationship. The paragraph headings are for convenience only and form no part hereof.

13. Signatures. In witness whereof, the parties have caused their authorized representatives to execute this Agreement with their signatures below.
