

Medical Assisting Program Goals

- 1. To prepare medical assistants who are competent in the cognitive (knowledge), psychomotor (skills), and affective (behavior) learning domains to enter the profession.
- To meet or exceed the Three-Year Retention Rate Average for the Reporting Year <u>and</u> meet or exceed the Reporting Year College-wide Retention Benchmark.
- 3. To meet or exceed the Three-Year **Graduation Rate** Average for the Reporting Year <u>and</u> meet or exceed the Reporting Year College-wide Graduation Benchmark.
- 4. To meet or exceed the Three-Year **Placement Rate** Average for the Reporting Year <u>and</u> meet or exceed the Reporting Year College-wide Placement Benchmark.
- 5. To have 80% of graduates responding to the **Graduate Exit Survey** record satisfaction with education, technical instruction, and skills preparation for work provided by the College.
- 6. To have 80% of employers responding to the **Employer Follow-Up** Survey record that **prior year** graduates meet and or exceed expectations with work ethics, job specific knowledge and skills, and overall education and training related to job requirements.
- 7. To maintain accreditation from the American Association of Medical Assistants (AAMA) through the Commission on the Accreditation of Allied Health Programs (CAAHEP).
- 8. To have 80% of graduates successfully complete the CMA (AAMA) certification exam.
