WHAT IS THE DUAL ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAM?

Students choose to simultaneously earn a high school diploma with the Academy of Learning and Performance and two technical certificates of credit, a technical diploma, or a college associate degree at Southern Regional Technical College in a specific career pathway to meet high school graduation requirements.

Dual Achievement is ideal for students seeking a new environment to complete their high school course requirements while earning college credentials to prepare them for in-demand careers.

PREREQUISITES FOR ENROLLMENT

Students must be between the ages 16-21

- Students must have officially withdrawn from their high school and provide with withdrawal form to the Academy of Learning and Performance along with an official transcript.
- Students must successfully complete at least 6 of the following required high school courses (core) prior to DAP admission:
 - 2 English/Language Arts
 - 2 Math
 - 2 Sciences
 - 2 Social Studies
 - 1 Health/PE

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must complete the 9 required high school courses AND any SRTC associate degree, diploma, or two approved technical certificates from one of the following areas:

- Accounting
- Air Conditioning Technology
- Automotive Technology
- Business Technology Construction
- Criminal Justice Technology
- Drafting Technology
- Early Childhood Care and Education
- Healthcare
- Industrial Systems Technology
- Information Technology
- Paramedicine
- Welding & Joining Technology



Students will earn a recognized High School Diploma offered online through e-campus from the Academy of Learning and Performance along with two technical certificates, a diploma or an associate's degree from SRTC.
