

LaGrange College and Technical College System of Georgia
TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Introduction

This agreement formally recognizes that LaGrange College (LC) and the schools of the Technical College System of Georgia (TCSG) are active educational partners in providing educational opportunities for currently enrolled and potential students of both institutions to serve the health care demands of the Georgia community. Agreement to this partnership requires a commitment by all institutions to serve and facilitate a student's ability to transfer into a degree without jeopardizing the intended mission and stated goals of either institution.

Agreement on Communication

LC and TCSG agree to cooperate in communicating with each other concerning the articulation relationship between the institutions. Communications may include common publications and announcements concerning their affiliation. Announcements of this signed articulation or of changes in the relationship will have a coordinated release to the public from both institutions. The institutions will encourage the dissemination of information about programs in this agreement with interested and qualified students, with both institutions providing advising and counseling to prospective students.

Agreement on Articulated Courses

Admission

Any student who receives the Associate Diploma of Nursing (ADN) or Associate of Science of Nursing (ASN) from TCSG, has passed the NCLEX, and is currently working as an RN in Georgia may enter into this transfer agreement with LC. Students who have satisfied these requirements are automatically accepted into LC's RN-BSN Bridge Program.

Completion

Students entering this program must achieve a cumulative GPA of 2.000 and complete the following courses (course credits in parentheses) to receive the BSN:

- NURS 3411 Health Assessment for RNs (4)
- NURS 3413 Transition to Professional Nursing (3)
- NURS 3440 Theories and Policy Perspective (3)
- NURS 3431 Pharmacology (4)
- NURS 4444 Evidenced Based Practice/Research (3)
- NURS 4441 Community Health (4)
- NURS 4460 Leadership in Nursing (5)
- NURS 4461 Capstone: Global Health Care Issues, Trends, and Informatics (4)

Note: *NURS3411 Health Assessment for RNs* and *NURS3431 Pharmacology* may be challenged by exam.

NURS4441 Community Health and *NURS4460 Leadership in Nursing* have clinical components (approximately 40 and 108 hours, respectively) that will be addressed on an individual basis during the course.

Entry into this program does not guarantee that requirements for the BSN will be completed within any specified time frame. While the program typically takes 1 – 2 years, the timeline for completion will vary across students.

Agreement on Maintenance and Review

One individual from LC and one from TCSG will be appointed to act as primary contacts and agents for this agreement, to speak for the institution, and to communicate details and modifications to respective faculty, advisors, and others with interest at the individual institutions.






