



This is a five-year average of the number of student graduates who pass the American Registry of Radiologic Technology (ARRT) exam on the first attempt within six months of graduation. After collecting the data, we average the pass rates over a period of five year. The outcome demonstrated was 83%.

## Program Completion Rate

The program has determined that 70% is its bench mark over a five year period. The number of students graduated divided by the number of students started will determine the retention rate. The retention rate is then averaged over a period of five years.
