

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

St. Matthew's University, School of Veterinary Medicine & Southern Regional Technical College

This ARTICULATION AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made the 1st day of July, 2019, between St. Matthew's University School of Veterinary Medicine (hereinafter "St. Matthew's University"), and Southern Regional Technical College (hereinafter "SRTC").

WHEREAS, SRTC enrolls students in its Veterinary Technology Associate of Applied Science degree program (hereinafter "VTP");

Whereas, both parties are desirous of assuring qualified SRTC VTP graduates acceptance for admission to St. Matthew's University in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, both parties agree as follows:

1. St. Matthew's University will accept for admission to its educational program leading to the Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree (D.V.M.) all qualified VTP graduates of SRTC who successfully complete the VTP program in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.
2. In addition to completing the VTP program, a student must meet the following minimum requirements in order to be admitted to St. Matthew's University pursuant to this Agreement:
 - a. An overall Grade Point Average of 2.7 or higher;
 - b. No un-remediated "F" or "D" grade in any core course of the VTP program;
 - c. A recommendation for admission by a St. Matthew's University Admissions interviewer.
3. St. Matthew's University represents that the requirements for earning the D.V.M. degree are described in the School of Veterinary Medicine Catalog, and are subject to change from time to time. St. Matthew's University does not represent that students admitted pursuant to this Agreement will be able to complete the D.V.M. requirements. Each student is responsible for planning his or her pre-veterinary education to develop skills necessary to succeed in a demanding professional degree program.
4. SRTC will provide its VTP students with information regarding this Agreement.
5. This Agreement is effective upon execution. Either party may terminate this Agreement for any reason by giving the other one hundred eighty (180) days written notice. The termination shall be effective at the end of the notice period, or at such later date as the party giving notice may specify. Any SRTC student who applies to and is admitted to St. Matthew's University prior

to termination of this Agreement shall be allowed to matriculate in the D.V.M. program at St. Matthew's University.

6. Each party represents that the individual signing this Agreement on behalf of its institution is authorized to do so.
